## Message from Fr. Quinn

**Praise the Lord!** The spaghetti and chicken dinner was already two full weeks ago. It was such a joy to see such a wonderful turnout. The line for the food got very lengthy at one point, stretching all the way to the back corner of the parish center. There was a good spirit of community and the food was fantastic. A special thank you to those involved in the preparation of the meal. It was beautiful to see new faces both there for the meal and for volunteering to serve. The opportunity to share the faith and be with others while enjoying food is so good to build community. We hope the line is just as lengthy for the next chicken and spaghetti meal on November 22nd.

Speaking of lengthy, the cold weather has finally begun to sink in and we are bracing for a frigid winter. The garage roof is now repaired and the black mold has been removed from the inside. Thank you to those who saw the necessity to fix the garage and were supportive of the project. Many of you are preparing your homes and properties for a long and lengthy winter. The long liturgical season is coming to a conclusion with Advent around the corner on November 28th. Jesus, in speaking about the scribes says, "They devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext recite lengthy prayers." Sometimes lengthy prayers can be a hollow pretext. Being on guard against the temptation to make up some long and convoluted excuse in our lives can be dangerous. For example, if we are covering our tracks and backpedaling a mistake or an error we had made, we come up with a long winded explanation of things. If a priest begins to stall out on his homily, he can repeat himself over and over again to make a long closing. Long meetings can be the opposite of life-giving and suck the wind right out of our sails. In long trips somewhere we can become tired and begin to drift asleep not keeping our attention and focus on the road. There is a spiritual danger to "lengthy prayers," but all the while in a short, focused and resolved manner the widow puts a, "two small coins worth a few cents," into the treasury. This is the action of grace. In an instant, grace can infuse a soul. In seconds, the words of consecration can change bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ. In a moment, forgiveness can be received through the words of absolution in the Sacrament of Confession. A day in the eyes of God are as a thousand years and a thousands years are as a day in God's eyes. Let's be aware this week to not lengthen our excuses not to pray, but cooperate with God's grace in the short and concise duration of time He gives us.

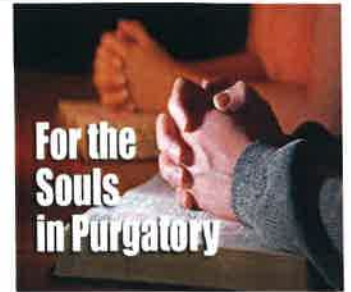
