Message from Fr. Quinn

Praise the Lord! Merry Christmas! God has visited His people! God the Father, in His marvelous wisdom and divine compassion has sent the Savior of the world born for us today! Hosanna in the Highest! King of kings and Lord of Lords! He is the Christ-child born in the lowly manger in Bethlehem. In a stable or a cave, no matter, Jesus Christ a Savior is born for us this Christmas Day. The star guides the Magi. The shepherds are announced glad tidings of peace and joy. The light of God's love pierces the cloak of dark shadow and death. Merry Christmas! This solemnity of the incarnation is right up there with the solemnity of the resurrection. A divine mystery of God's love revealing His Sovereignty over sin and death.
