priest resides.

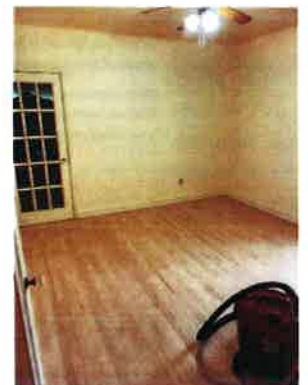
A rectory fund has been started to repair and

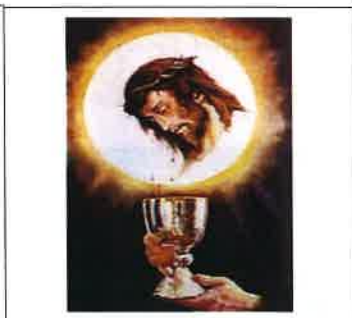
