Let's not be shocked by the power of Jesus' teaching but marvel in the power their meaning. Let's not be shocked by our capacity to do deeds of service but thank God for even the grace to attempt to serve in and of itself. I am afraid we begin to focus on the wrong things, the negative things instead of the great good and thereby become shocked by them rather than expecting the great good to occur. We must be on the look out of the enemy's tactic that can entrench our outlook thereby leading us away from being shocked to being hopeful.                      Now & Forever!     Fr. Quinn
