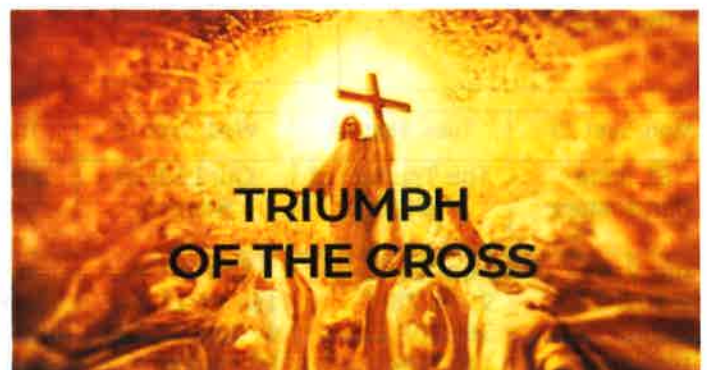

Jesus Christ is our Savior for a reason. Only Christ can ground us in reality because the Cross defines the Truth we can choose to live.
