


Lenten Reflection on the Eucharist




LENTEN REGULATIONS. Each Catholic is asked to preserve the penitential purpose and character of Lent, which begins Ash Wednesday. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday until they celebrate their 59th birthday fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (only eat one full meal or two smaller meals if necessary to maintain strength - eating solid foods between meals is not permitted). These practices are designed for spiritual growth. Catholics are not to excuse themselves lightly from these prescribed minimal penitential practices. In 2024, Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14. Good Friday is March 29, Easter Vigil is March 30, and Easter Sunday is March 31, 2024.
