CORPUS CHRISTI EUCHARISTIC

PROCESSION Sunday June 22nd 12:30pm
Meet at Immaculate Conception, Iron Mountain 1.5 miles procession to St. Mary's & St. Joseph's, Iron Mountain.

Q: Why should we participate in the *Corpus Christi* procession?

A: The annual procession on the feast of *Corpus Christi* "holds particular importance and significance in the pastoral life of the parish or city.... In processions in which the Eucharist is carried through the streets in a solemn rite with singing, the Christian people bear public witness of faith and devotion to the Most Blessed Sacrament" (HCWEMOM, 101, 102). Says Pope John Paul II, "The devout participation of the faithful in the Eucharistic procession on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ is a grace from the Lord which yearly brings joy to those who take part in it" (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 10). He continues: "In the humble signs of bread and wine, changed into the body and blood, Christ walks beside us as our strength and our food for the journey, and he enables us to become, for everyone, witnesses of hope" (62). ~(from *Adoremus*)
