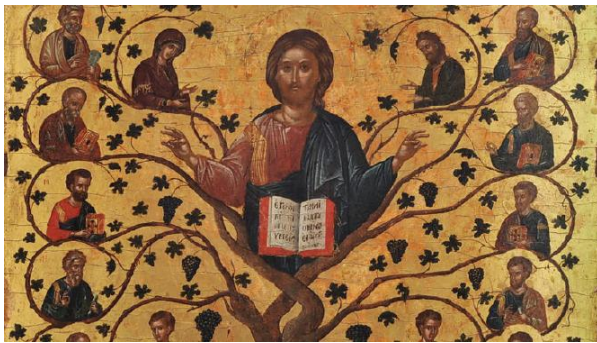

Obligatory Sacrifices

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **FASTING** for those 18-59. Only those who are pregnant, nursing, or suffer from a health condition where fasting is harmful are excused from this obligation. Even those who are exempt can still choose food purely for health benefits rather than taste. For those obliged to fast, it means eating one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but they should not exceed that one full meal. This is broadly stated for each person to adjust according to their usual diet. Those 14 and older are to abstain from eating meat and meat products on Ash Wednesday and **all Fridays in or out of Lent** (outside Lent, those in the USA may choose a different penance on Friday)
