#### **Description of Corpus Christi Procession Route:**

1. Exit Immaculate Conception Church around 12:30 pm and proceed to the back of the church towards Stanton St.
2. Turn left onto Stanton St. and proceed west towards Millie St.
3. Turn left onto Millie St. and proceed south towards Blaine St.
4. Turn right onto Blaine St. and head west towards Vulcan St.
5. Turn left onto Vulcan St. and head south towards E. Main St.
6. Turn right onto E. Main St. and head west towards Stephenson Ave. (U.S. 2).
7. Turn left onto the side walk of U.S. 2 and proceed South towards E. Ludington St.
8. At E. Ludington St. cross U.S. 2 and continue west on E. Ludington St. heading towards Prospect Ave.
9. Turn left onto Prospect Ave. and proceed to the entrance of St. Mary's and St. Joseph's Catholic Church (the conclusion of the walk).
