

The appearance of the Blessed Mother to a young Belgian woman immigrant in 1859 near Champion, Wisconsin, was officially approved by the Church in 2010. Since then, the numbers of pilgrims have increased from around 10,000 per year to nearly 200,000.

Many parishioners in our own diocese have never been there for a visit. I look forward to the day in the near future when each parish will bring a busload or more on pilgrimage to seek the intercession of Our Lady of Good Help for themselves and their parishes. 
