Eucharistic Revival: The Church is gearing up for a Eucharistic Revival to help the faithful better appreciate the reality of Jesus' presence in the Eucharist. We just finished the series of bulletin quotes on Bishop Ricken's Pastoral Letter on the Eucharist. Moving forward, we will take random insights from saints and theologians on how to better appreciate this amazing Gift from God.

Jesus is always present in the Eucharist, yet we may not obtain the fullness of grace in receiving Him in Holy Communion if we do not have the proper disposition. Check out this article on the kind of disposition we are to foster while receiving our Lord in Holy Communion: spiritualdirection.com/2023/08/24/spiritual-dispositions-for-holy-communion. In summary, we learn that this disposition begins with being in a state of grace (no known mortal sins). Our disposition must also consist of fostering faith in the Eucharist, humility before the Eucharist, confidence in the Eucharist, a desire for the Eucharist, and reverence for the Eucharist.
