
Council's Corner:

"See, my daughter, My Heart surrounded with thorns with which ingrates pierce me at every moment with blasphemies and ingratitude. You, at least, make sure to console me and announce that all those who for five months, on the first Saturdays, go to confession, receive Communion, say five decades of the Rosary and keep me company for 15 minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making reparation to Me, I promise to assist them at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls." Part VI – "Five Alive" Practices To Live the Mass #3 Eucharistic Adoration

Many people wonder what to do in Adoration. The word of God gives us the answer. In the psalms we are urged to "be still and know that I am God." What is important is that you are here. Give yourself the gift of peace and quiet with the King of Peace in Eucharistic Adoration. St. Catherine Labouré reminds us that silence is a masterful teacher, for it is in the stillness that God speaks. She said, "Whenever I go to the chapel, I put myself in the presence of our good Lord, and I say to him, 'Lord, I am here. Tell me what you would have me to do.'... And then, I tell God everything that is in my heart. I tell him about my pains and my joys, and then I listen. If you listen, God will also speak to you, for with the good Lord, you have to both speak and listen. God always speaks to you when you approach him plainly and simply." (pg. 36)
