


CORPUS CHRISTI EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION

Conception, 1.5 mile procession to St. Mary's & St. Joseph's



- We are searching for people to set up water stations along the way,

Description of Corpus Christi Procession Route:

- 1. Exit Immaculate Conception Church around 12:30 pm and proceed to the back of the church towards Stanton St.
- 2. Turn left onto Stanton St. and proceed west towards Millie St.
- 3. Turn left onto Millie St. and proceed south towards Blaine St.
- 4. Turn right onto Blaine St. and head west towards Vulcan St.
- 5. Turn left onto Vulcan St. and head south towards E. Main St.
- 6. Turn right onto E. Main St. and head west towards Stephenson Ave. (U.S. 2).
- 7. Turn left onto the side walk of U.S. 2 and proceed South towards E. Ludington St.
- 8. At E. Ludington St. cross U.S. 2 and continue west on E. Ludington St. heading towards Prospect Ave.
- 9. Turn left onto Prospect Ave. and proceed to the entrance of St. Mary's and St. Joseph's Catholic Church (the conclusion of the walk).
